District 50

The District boundaries of this District shall be as follows:

Arkansas:

All counties except for Benton, Crawford, Crittenden, Lee, Mississippi, Phillips, Sebastian, St. Francis, and Washington.

Louisiana:

The portion north of the southern border of the following parishes:
De Soto, Red River, Bienville, Jackson, Caldwell, Franklin, and Tensas.

Texas:

The portion east of the western borders of the following counties:
Grayson, Collin, Ellis, Navarro, Limestone, and Robertson. And the portion of Dallas County east of I-35E to exclude the cities of Coppell, Grand Prairie, and Irving.

The portion north of the southern borders of the following counties:
Robertson, Leon, Houston, Trinity, Angelina, San Augustine, and Sabine.

District 56

The District boundaries of this District shall be as follows:

Louisiana:

The parishes south of the northern border of the following parishes:
Sabine, Natchitoches, Winn, LaSalle, Catahoula, and Concordia

The parishes west of the eastern border of the following parishes:
Avoyelles, Evangeline, Jefferson Davis, Cameron

Texas:

The portion east of the western border of the following counties:
Madison, Grimes, Waller, Fort Bend, Wharton, and Matagorda.

The portion south of the northern border of the following counties:
Madison, Walker, San Jacinto, Polk, Tyler, Jasper, and Newton

District 77

The District boundaries of this District shall be as follows:

Alabama

Mississippi

Arkansas:

The counties of Crittendon, Lee, Mississippi, Phillips, and St. Francis.

Florida:

The portion west of the eastern border of the following counties:
Jackson, Calhoun, and Gulf – also known as west of the Apalachicola River.

Kentucky:

The town of Fulton only, which lies in both Kentucky and Tennessee.

Louisiana:

The portion east of the western border of the following parishes:
West Feliciana, Pointe Coupee, St. Landry, Acadia, and Vermillion.

Tennessee:

The portion west of the Tennessee River and Kentucky Lake.
